Organisation

Rules

The ITTF rules shall be applied with the non-essential unavoidable exceptions.

Eligibility

The Championships are open to all players of Estonia, Latvia and Lithuania table tennis associations who are 40 years of age at December 31st 2015 or elder. Proof of age must be available on request.

 - 40-44 years (born 1975 or earlier),
 - 45-49 years (born 1970 or earlier),
 - 50-54 years (born 1965 or earlier),
 - 55-59 years (born 1960 or earlier),
 - 60-64 years (born 1955 or earlier),
 - 65-69 years (born 1950 or earlier),
 - 70-74 years (born 1945 or earlier),
 - 75-79 years (born 1940 or earlier),
 - 80-84 years (born 1935 or earlier),
 - 85 or over years (born 1930)

- **Categories for Women's Doubles and Men's Doubles:**

- 40-49 years (born 1975 or earlier),
- 50-59 years (born 1965 or earlier),
- 60-69 years (born 1955 or earlier),
- 70-79 years (born 1945 or earlier).
- 80 or over years (born 1935 or earlier).

System of play

- Every entered player is allowed to participate in one singles and one doubles event.
- A player must participate in her/his own age category, except in doubles if the players of a pair do not belong to the same age group, in which case they shall have to compete in the category of the younger player.
- Each category, singles and doubles, will be played best of 5 games, except consolation competitions. Consolation competitions will be played best of 3 games.
- If there will be 7 or more players or pairs in an event, there will be played the Qualifying Competitions in groups by 4 (3) players or pairs. The first and second placed in qualifying groups will play the Championships Competition according to the single knock-out system. The other singles from qualifying groups will play in Consolation Competition knock-out system.
- For doubles consolation competitions will not be played.
- If there are less than 4 players or pairs in an event, they will play in younger Age Category, but awards will be given in all categories.

Draw

The draw will take place **May 7th from 1700.**

Umpires

- The Organiser will provide umpires for the Championships Competitions.
- In the Qualifying Competition, members of the group not playing, shall make themselves available as umpires.

- In the Consolation Competition, the loser of the match, shall umpire the next match at the table, where he or she have played.

Equipment

- 10 “Butterfly Space Saver - 22” blue and 6 Joola Duomat blue tables
- DHS*** white balls (plastic) will be used
- Racket covering must be ITTF authorised.

Prizes

First places gold medals, second places silver medals and semifinals losers bronze medals. Winners of the consolation singles event in each Category will receive medals and diplomas.
